

Northwick Park Hospital

T&B Building Contractors carried out a £350K refurbishment on the ninth floor patient's ward at Northwick Park Hospital in London.

Northwick Park Hospital is located in Harrow and is managed by The North West London Hospitals NHS Trust. Each year, the Trust cares for more than half a million people living across Brent, Harrow and beyond – making it one of the busiest NHS Trusts in the capital. Because of this, the construction work had to be carried out whilst the department remained fully functional.

Part of the refurbishment was to install ten secure vision panels in the Jonson Isolation Ward (Intestinal Failure Unit) which is used for patients requiring nutritional assessment and management assessment.
